## **Autumn 2012 Sunday Night Mixed Competition Entry Information**

Main Venue: Northern Beaches Indoor Sports Centre, Jacksons Road, Warriewood  
Team Entries Due: Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> February 2012  
Competition commences: Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> Feb 2012  
Finals Day: Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> May 2012  
Cost per Adult Team: \$720  
Cost per Junior Team: \$500

The competition fee must accompany all entry forms otherwise the entry may not be accepted.

Please read the Conditions of Entry and Competition Details carefully before completing the attached entry form. The MWVA reserves the right to not accept any entry, which is incomplete or incorrect.

### **Conditions of Entry & Competition Details**

#### **1. Membership**

All players must be members of the Manly Warringah Volleyball Association. All players have until the conclusion of the second competition game to complete the individual membership form and pay the membership fee (see the attached Schedule of Charges). After week two, unregistered players will not be allowed to enter the court. Teams using an unregistered player (or players) after week two will lose competition points or will be deemed to forfeit the match.

#### **2. Competitions**

The MWVA runs three (3) Sunday Night Mixed Competitions during the year. There will be 10 weeks of regular competition plus a finals day.

#### **3. Venue**

Primary Venue for games: Northern Beaches Indoor Sports Centre, Jacksons Road, Warriewood.

#### **4. Format**

The format of all competitions is round games, followed by a Finals Day. All round games are best of 5 sets, subject to the time limit (60mins). All round games start at the advertised time with a 15 minute warm up period followed by 60 minutes of game time. Start times for round games are 5.30pm, 6.45pm, and 8.00pm. Grand Final games will be the best of five sets with no time limit.

#### **5. Rules**

All games will be played under the FIVB Rules as amended by current MWVA Competition By-laws.

#### **6. Divisions**

<b>Divisions</b>	<b>Team Format</b>	<b>Level</b>
Division 1	Mixed	Advanced
Division 2	Mixed	Experienced/ Intermediate
Division 3	Mixed	Intermediate/Novice
Division 4	School or Mixed	School teams/Novices

Mixed: Maximum of 4 males permitted on court at any one time (except junior teams.) No restriction of the number of females permitted on court (up to the 6 player limit). (Teams typically play with 3 - 4 males and 2 - 3 females on court.) New teams may nominate their preferred division on the Entry Form, however the MWVA reserves the right to place new or existing teams in a different division as it sees fit. Usually, this would be done to achieve the balance of teams in a division and/or to maintain a minimum standard within a division.

#### **7. Competition Fees**

The competition team fee covers all costs directly associated with the competition including court hire, equipment, court supervisors, trophies and administration.

#### **8. Teams**

Teams must nominate a minimum of 6 players, although the MWVA strongly recommends teams of at least 8

players to help avoid forfeits. For all divisions teams of 3 females (minimum) and 5 males are suggested. Each team must also have a Team Representative and a Reserve Representative as the official point of contact between MWVA and the team. Teams requiring additional players must attend grading night to meet and select players. We will attempt to match any new and unplaced players with teams on Grading Night.

### 9. Payment of Fees

The FULL competition fee MUST be lodged with the completed application form. The Team Representative will be responsible for dividing the team fee amongst their players and arranging collection of all monies. Full payment to the MWVA by a single cheque is preferred, however, full payment made up of several cheques and/or cash will be accepted provided all monies are received by the MWVA at one time.

### 10. Uniforms

From the third week of competition, all players will be required to wear the team uniform. Uniforms consist of shirts of matching colour, style and design. Teams not meeting the uniform requirement will incur a mandatory penalty deduction of 1 competition point for each game concerned. Players from a lower division team playing in a higher division team shall be considered to be in uniform if the player is wearing the uniform of the player's lower division team.

### 11. Duty

Each team is required to perform duty throughout the competition. Duty teams must, according to the roster, supply up to five of either (the number may vary – please check the draw)

a) "1<sup>st</sup> Referee" - five 1<sup>st</sup> referees (one for each court)

b) "2<sup>nd</sup> Referee" - five 2<sup>nd</sup> referees (one for each Court)

c) "Scorer" - five scorers (one for each court)

Duty teams must report to the Court Supervisor's table at the beginning of the warm up period to collect Match Balls and the Scoresheets. Whistles are not given out by the MWVA, although they are available for purchase. At the end of the match, it is the responsibility of the 1<sup>st</sup> Referee to mark the scoresheet regarding Uniforms and to nominate the Best and Fairest. The 1st Referee must then ensure the scoresheet is correctly completed, and signed by both team captains before returning it and the match ball to the Court Supervisor's table. All teams for the first game (5.30pm) are required to be at the Centre by 5pm to set up the courts. All teams for the last game are required to take down nets and posts and clean the Centre of any rubbish left behind. Teams failing to properly fulfil their duty will incur a penalty of up to three competition points.

### 12. Finals Matches

During Finals matches, the MWVA endeavours to supply qualified referees. Players and teams should therefore expect a higher standard of refereeing during finals matches.

### 13. Social Training

The MWVA runs training sessions for social members at Cromer Community Centre, Fisher Rd North, Dee Why on Wednesday nights, 7:30pm.

## Schedule of Charges

(All costs include GST)

### 1. Competition Team Fee

\$720 per senior team

\$500 per junior team (all members must be under 19 years and not turn 19 in the current year)

### 2. Membership & Registration

Adult \$80.00 (19 years or older)

Junior \$50.00 (Under 19 years)

MWVA membership includes State Volleyball NSW and Australian Volleyball Federation membership.

### MWVA membership entitles a player to:

- Play in MWVA social competitions.
- Attend Social Training.
- Be eligible for selection in MWVA Representative Teams.

- Exercise voting rights as a member at the AGM and any Special General meetings of the Association.

### State Volleyball NSW membership includes:

- Player accident insurance cover.
- Eligibility to compete in SVNSW endorsed competitions, leagues and tournaments.
- Eligibility for selection in any SVNSW State Team program.

Players already independently registered with SVNSW (i.e. with another district association) are not required to pay the SVNSW component of the MWVA membership fee. Proof of SVNSW membership will be required for this exemption. Please enquire as to the appropriate fee.
